GENERATION #1

Agnes Livingstone – sister of Neil Livingstone, father of Dr. David Livingstone.
Dr. Livingstone born March 19th. 1813 at Balantyre, Lanarkshire, Scotland (on the river Clyde), died on May 4th. 1875 at Thola, Central Africa.
He was a well known Doctor, Missionary and Explorer. (AFRICA)

Agnes Livingstone married Alexander McFayden. (Aunt to Dr. Livingstone)

Their daughter, Agnes McFayden was born in 1803.

Agnes McFayden, b. 1803, married Alexander Graham in Highland, Argyleshire Scotland, and was buried in Grennock, Scotland.

GENERATION #3

Margaret (Maggie) b. July 20/1831 in Argyleshire, Scotland and came to Canada with her sisters Annie, Catherine (Katie), and Mary in 1855. They came on the ship 'John McKenzie' from Greenock, Scotland. It took 6 weeks and 3 days to make the voyage. She and her sisters came to the home of their uncle, Colin McFayden, who was a pioneer living on Lot 19, Concession 1, Bagot Township (Burnstown, Ontario) where they made their home until they married. Maggie married William Thompson (b. 1837; d. 1921) son of William Thompson and Mary McFayden at Burnstown Ont. Jan. 14/1862. They moved to Matawatchan Ont. in 1862. Maggie died April 14/1922 at the age of 90. Her husband died on March 30/1921. They are both buried in the Matawatchan cemetery. They had 8 children, three sons and five daughters (one still-born).
